- You have to have your bike registered with the City and/or Campus Police to park your bike on Campus
- There are "No Ride" zones in some areas around campus from 8am-5pm, Mon-Fri (Check website for more details)
- Evolve-Revolve: a group of graduate students working towards more bicycle transportation to and around campus
- Bike Library/ Pokes Spoke: a fleet of Cruisers to rent to students and faculty for \$10 per semester run by the Outdoor Adventure program
